GOD'S PROVIDENCE

Today's Readings celebrate God's providence. No matter how wonderful (or heartbreaking) our relationships are, God always provides for us. No one cares for us the way God does.

Isaiah delights us with a deeply intimate image of God caring for us "as a mother comforts her child." The prophet describes us not as the usual "children of God," but as "babies." We should not resist this image, but rejoice in it. Trusting in God's care, we can all let down our guard and rest like infants in the lap of our mother.

Saint Paul's trust in God allows him to be at peace like this. He boldly declares that no one can "make troubles" for him, because he has given himself completely to Jesus. And when Jesus sends His disciples out to preach and heal, he challenges them not to provide for themselves, but to let faith be their guide.

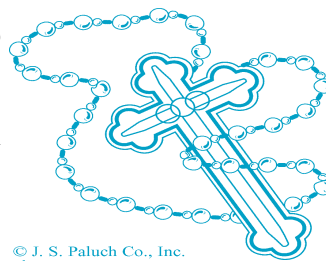

WHO IS YOUR FAVORITE SAINT ?

Saturday, July 6th, is the Feast Day of **St. Maria Goretti**, an Italian virgin-martyr of the Catholic Church, and one of the youngest canonized saints. She was born to a farming family. She was born on Oct. 16, 1890 and died July 6, 1902 at the age of 11. Maria Goretti was beatified by Pope Pius XII in a ceremony at Saint Peter's Basilica on April 27, 1947. Three years later, on June 24, 1950, Maria was declared a saint and Alessandro, her murderer, was present in the St. Peter's crowd to celebrate her canonization. She is the youngest canonized saint in the Catholic Church's long and storied history. Her life is a witness to purity, mercy and forgiveness. On her feast day in 2003, Pope John Paul II spoke about St. Maria Goretti at his Sunday Angelus, noting that her life provides an exemplary witness of what it means to be "pure of heart."
