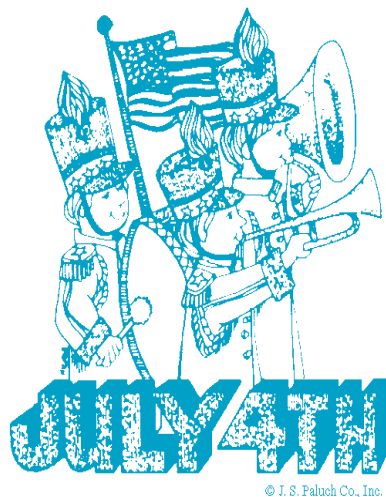
TODAY'S READINGS

Gospel — Go and proclaim the kingdom of God. (Luke 9:51-62).

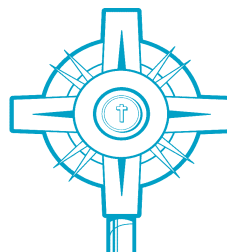

UPDATE ON SB 360 — KEEP THE SEAL

Thousands of Catholics, through the efforts of dioceses around California and the California Catholic Conference, are contacting their Assembly members to object to the infringement of religious freedom that SB 360 represents. The bill threatens to remove the right to privacy between a penitent and confessor during the Sacrament of Reconciliation and other spiritual counseling for priests and employees of the Church.

SB 360 will be heard next in the Assembly Public Safety Committee though no date has been announced. **We ask that you quickly take a moment to sign the petition at**

We cannot overstate the importance of working to ensure that this bill does not become law. The dire consequences for priests and people of the Catholic faith are likely to snowball if this first step is approved.
